Mladi raziskovalec (MR) se bo usposabljal na širšem področju književne teorije, literarnovedne metodologije in literarne zgodovine, ožje na področju slovenistične literarne vede (v vseh treh prej naštetih segmentih) in še ožje na področjih empirične, prostorske, interkulturne, medijske in kognitivne literarne vede, kar so tudi specialna raziskovalna področja mentorice. Z enega od teh področij bo tudi tema doktorske naloge, kjer je v sodelovanju z mentorico posebej zaželena kandidatova izvirnost in aktualnost teme.

MR se bo skozi svoje delo priključil raziskovalnemu programu oz. raziskovalnim projektom, pri katerih bo sodelovala mentorica, prav tako pa bo aktivno sodeloval pri prijavljanju novih projektov na domačih in drugih razpisih ter pomagal pri organiziranju znanstvenih dogodkov.

Zaželeno je, da ima kandidat izkušnje na področju empiričnega raziskovanja ali vsaj afiniteto do empiričnih znanstvenih metod, da je konceptualno in metodološko inovativen, da ima kako izkušnjo pri pisanju strokovnih in znanstvenih besedil (zelo dobrodošle so objave), da je vedoželen, kritično razmišlja, učinkovit in ima tudi delovno vnemo. Prednost bodo imeli kandidati, ki imajo sposobnosti in ideje za interdisciplinarno sodelovanje (tako z družboslovnimi kot naravoslovnimi disciplinami) in so po znanosti širše razgledani. Priporočljivo je obvladovanje informacijsko-komunikacijskih tehnologij. Kandidat mora tekoče/aktivno obvladati vsaj en tuji jezik; zaradi strokovne in znanstvene literature z naštetih področij pa je posebej zaželeno znanje nemščine.

MR bo razen v raziskovalne vključen tudi v pedagoške oblike dela mentorice, kamor spadajo zlasti seznanitev z vsebinami slovenističnih študijskih programov in zlasti predmetov, katerih nosilka je mentorica, morebitna pomoč pri izvedbah vaj in seminarjev pri teh predmetih, zamisli za izboljšavo študijskega oz. učnega gradiva.

The junior researcher will train broadly in the field of literary theory, literary studies methodologies, and literary history, and specifically in the field of Slovene literary studies (in all three named areas), and more specifically in the fields of empirical, spatial, intercultural, media, and cognitive literary studies, which are also the mentor's fields of research specialization. One of these fields will, moreover, be the area of the doctoral dissertation, on which in cooperating with the mentor, originality on the part of the candidate and relevancy of the topic are especially desirable.

During the course of her or his work, the junior researcher will join the research program, cooperating with the mentor on research projects, and will also take active part in proposing new projects in response to funding opportunities in Slovenia and elsewhere, and will assist in organizing scholarly events.

It is desirable that the candidate have experience in the field of empirical research or at least an affinity for empirical scholarly methods, be intellectually and methodologically innovative, have a degree of experience in writing scholarly and academic texts (publications are highly valued), be intellectually curious, think critically, be efficient, and possess a good work ethic. Candidates having abilities and ideas for interdisciplinary collaboration (with the social and natural sciences) and having a broad academic perspective will receive preference. It is recommended that the candidate is well versed with use of information communication technology. The candidate must have fluent, active command of at least one foreign language; in view of the scholarly, academic literature in the named fields, a knowledge of German is especially desirable.

In addition to research, the junior researcher will also be involved in aspects of the mentor's teaching work, to which is particularly related an acquaintance with the contents of Slovene studies academic programs, and foremost subjects for which the mentor is responsible; possible assistance in holding course and seminar meetings in these subjects; and ideas for improving academic, pedagogical materials.
