

In accordance with the constitutionally guaranteed autonomy of the University and pursuant to the Higher Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 32/12 – official consolidated version, 40/12 – ZUJF, 57/12 – ZPCP-2D, 109/12, 85/14, 75/16, 61/17 – ZUPŠ and 65/17) and the Order on the reorganisation of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 28/00, 33/03, 79/04, 36/06, 18/09, 83/10 and 8/19) the Senate of the University of Ljubljana at its session of 28 January 2020 and the Governing Board of the University of Ljubljana at its session of 10 June 2021 adopted the following

amendments to the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana

Article 1

In the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 28/00, 33/03, 79/04, 36/06, 18/09, 83/10, 8/19, 36/21) Annex 1 shall be amended to read:

“Fields of study at individual faculties and art academies, classified in accordance with the decree on the introduction and use of the KLASIUS-P-16 education and training classification system, shall be specified for each member faculty of the UL.

Fields of study by member faculties of the UL shall be defined by the classification of study programmes carried out independently by member faculties of the UL in at least one of three cycles, into broad KLASIUS-P-16 fields. Individual study programmes carried out jointly by two or more member faculties of the UL shall be interdisciplinary study programmes comprising content from various KLASIUS-P-16 fields (e. g. options, fields or sets). Each member faculty of the UL shall participate in carrying out interdisciplinary programmes with content from the fields set out for each member faculty of the UL in this Annex.

- **Biotechnical Faculty:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics, (07) Technology, production technology and construction, (08) Agriculture, forestry, fishery and veterinary science (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master’s study programme in Applied Statistics and interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Biosciences, Biomedicine, Statistics and Environmental Protection*);
- **School of Economics and Business:** (03) Social sciences, journalism and information science, (04) Business and administrative sciences, law (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master’s study programmes in Sports Management and Applied Statistics, as well as interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Statistics and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Architecture:** (07) Technology, production technology and construction;

- **Faculty of Social Sciences:** (03) Social sciences, journalism and information science, (04) Business and administrative sciences, law (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programme in Applied Statistics and interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Humanities and Social Sciences, Statistics and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Electrical Engineering:** (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics, (06) Information and communication technology (ICT), (07) Technology, production technology and construction, (09) Health and social security (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programmes in Multimedia and Applied Statistics, the first-cycle academic study programme in Multimedia, and interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Biosciences and Statistics*);
- **Faculty of Pharmacy:** (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics, (07) Technology, production technology and construction, (09) Health and social security (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Biomedicine*);
- **Faculty of Civil and Geodetic Engineering:** (07) Technology, production technology and construction (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Built Environment and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics, (07) Technology, production technology and construction, (10) Transport, security, hospitality and tourism, personal services (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Built Environmental Protection and Materials Science and Engineering*);
- **Faculty of Mathematics and Physics:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics, (07) Technology, production technology and construction (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary second-cycle Master's study programmes in Applied Statistics and Computer Science and Mathematics, the interdisciplinary first-cycle academic study programme in Computer Science and Mathematics, and interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Statistics, Environmental Protection and Materials Science and Engineering*);
- **Faculty of Maritime Studies and Transport:** (07) Technology, production technology and construction, (10) Transport, security, hospitality and tourism, personal services (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Computer and Information Science:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (06) Information and communication technology (ICT) (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programmes in Cognitive Science, Computer Science and Mathematics, Multimedia, Applied Statistics, Computer and Information Science Education, and the first-cycle academic study programmes in Multimedia, Administrative IT, Computer Science and Mathematics, as well as the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Biosciences*);
- **Faculty of Social Work:** (09) Health and social security (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Humanities and Social Sciences*);

- **Faculty of Mechanical Engineering:** (07) Technology, production technology and construction, (10) Transport, security, hospitality and tourism, personal services (*participates in the interdisciplinary first-cycle academic study programme in Design Engineering and in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Biosciences and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Sport:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (10) Transport, security, hospitality and tourism, personal services (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programme in Sports Management*);
- **Faculty of Public Administration:** (04) Business and administration, law (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary first-cycle academic study programme in Administrative IT*);
- **Faculty of Arts:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (02) Arts and humanities, (03) Social sciences, journalism and information science, (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programme in Cognitive Science and interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Humanities and Social Sciences, Statistics and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Medicine:** (09) Health and social security (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programmes in Cognitive Science and Applied Statistics, and interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Biomedicine, Statistics and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Natural Sciences and Engineering:** (02) Arts and humanities, (05) Natural science, mathematics and statistics, (07) Technology, production technology and construction (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Built Environment and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Education:** (01) Education science and teacher training (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary Master's study programmes in Cognitive Science and Computer and Information Science Education*);
- **Faculty of Law:** (04) Business and administration, law (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Theology:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (02) Arts and humanities, (03) Social sciences, journalism and information science (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Humanities and Social Sciences*);
- **Veterinary Faculty:** (08) Agriculture, forestry, fishery and veterinary science (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programmes in Biomedicine and Environmental Protection*);
- **Faculty of Health Sciences:** (09) Health and social security (*participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Biosciences*);

- **Academy of Music:** (01) Education science and teacher training, (02) Arts and humanities *(participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Humanities and Social Sciences)*;
- **Academy of Theatre, Radio, Film and Television:** (02) Arts and humanities *(participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Humanities and Social Sciences)*;
- **Academy of Fine Arts and Design:** (02) Arts and humanities *(participates in carrying out the interdisciplinary first-cycle academic study programme in Design Engineering and interdisciplinary doctoral study programme in Humanities and Social Sciences)*.

Content interdisciplinarity of individual study programmes shall be enabled and ensured also in all study programmes where it is necessary to achieve the objectives of individual study programmes (the expected knowledge, competences and skills of graduates) and which are not specifically defined as interdisciplinary. The specific content of study programmes may also belong to other broad, narrow or detailed KLASIUS-P-16 fields in which the programmes or members of the UL are not classified under this Annex (e. g. the programmes in Speech therapy and deaf/hearing impaired education; Mathematics and statistics; Teacher training and education science; the doctoral study programme in Biosciences and others).”

Article 2

These amendments shall enter into force on the day after their publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia.
