Mladi raziskovalec¹ bo raziskovalno delo pod mentorstvom doc. dr. Nine Petek opravljal na Oddelku za filozofijo Filozofske fakultete Univerze v Ljubljani v okviru programske skupine »Filozofske raziskave« (P6-0252). Usposabljal se bo na širšem področju indijskih filozofsko-religijskih tokov. Z vsebinskega vidika bo poudarek zlasti na raziskovanju tantričnih šol (budističnih in/ali hindujskih), ki so se formirale v severnih in vzhodnih predelih Indije v obdobju med 11. in 16. stoletjem, in njihovem vplivu na sodobnejše izraze indijske filozofske misli z obzirom na širše kulturne in družbenopolitične kontekste. Podrobnejše področje raziskovanja ter s tem tudi tema doktorske naloge bosta opredeljena v dogovoru z izbranim kandidatom v skladu z njegovimi ožjimi raziskovalnimi interesi.

Delo mladega raziskovalca bo zasnovano kot poglobljen študij in interpretacija izbranih izvirnih filozofskih besedil, poleg tega pa je predvideno tudi raziskovalno delo v Indiji, med drugim na tamkajšnjih znanstvenoraziskovalnih institucijah, v knjižnicah in arhivih. Predvideno je tudi izpopolnjevanje na drugih tujih univerzah, kjer hranijo relevantno filozofsko gradivo, vezano na ožje področje raziskav. Kandidat bo svoje raziskovalne izsledke predstavljal znanstveni javnosti v obliki objav ter diseminacije raziskovalnih dognanj na domačih in mednarodnih konferencah in simpozijih. S tem bo svoje raziskovalne rezultate umeščal v širši mednarodni kontekst in prispeval k obogatitvi raziskav indijskih filozofsko-religijskih tradicij v slovenskem znanstvenem prostoru.

Mladi raziskovalec bo sodeloval tudi pri raziskavah, ki jih izvaja mentorica. Sodeloval bo pri organizaciji znanstvenih dogodkov (konference, simpoziji), pri pripravi in urejanju znanstvenih publikacij ter se vključeval v pedagoške oblike dela na Oddelku za filozofijo Filozofske fakultete UL (sodelovanje pri predmetih, katerih nosilka je mentorica). Usposabljanje bo zajemalo tudi delo na področjih, povezanih z raziskovalnimi izhodišči programske skupine "Filozofske raziskave", s čimer bo raziskovalno delo kandidata prispevalo k razvoju in doseganju njenih ciljev ter spodbujalo dialog z njegovim ožjim raziskovalnim področjem. Na ta način bo razširil svoja strokovna in raziskovalna obzorja ter pridobil dodatna znanja in veščine, ki bodo pomembno prispevala k snovanju doktorske disertacije.

Prednost imajo kandidati, ki so na vsaj eni stopnji študija (BA ali MA) zaključili študij filozofije (oziroma je zaključek magistrskega študija predviden še pred iztekom tekočega študijskega leta). Znanje katerega od azijskih jezikov, v katerem so zapisana temeljna filozofska besedila, ni predpogoj za nastop na delovnem mestu, se pa pričakuje, da kandidat v času zaposlitve usvoji osnove enega od relevantnih jezikov. Kandidat mora na visoki ravni obvladati verbalno in pisno komuniciranje v slovenskem in angleškem jeziku.

The young researcher will pursue doctoral research under the supervision of Assistant Professor Dr Nina Petek at the Department of Philosophy, Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana, within the research programme "Philosophical Investigations" (P6-0252). The position offers structured academic training in the broader field of Indian philosophical and religious traditions. The primary research focus will concern tantric traditions (Buddhist and/or Hindu) that developed in northern and eastern India between the eleventh and sixteenth centuries, and their influence on subsequent articulations of Indian philosophical thought in relation to wider cultural and socio-political contexts. The precise field of inquiry and the topic of the doctoral dissertation will be determined in consultation with the selected candidate, in accordance with their specific research interests and academic profile.

The work of the young researcher will be conceived as an in-depth study and interpretation of selected primary philosophical texts. In addition, research activity in India is envisaged, including work at academic and research institutions, as well as in libraries and archives. Further advanced training is also foreseen at other foreign universities that hold relevant philosophical materials pertaining to the candidate's more specialised field of research. The candidate will present their research findings to the scholarly community through academic publications and by disseminating research results at national and international conferences and symposia. In this way, they will situate their work within a broader international context and contribute to the advancement of research into Indian philosophical-religious traditions within the Slovenian academic sphere.

The young researcher will also collaborate on research conducted by the supervisor. They will participate in the organisation of academic events (conferences and symposia), assist in the preparation and editing of scholarly publications, and engage in teaching activities at the Department of Philosophy, Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana (participation in courses taught by the supervisor). The training will further encompass work in areas connected to the research foundations of the research programme "Philosophical Investigations", thereby ensuring that the candidate's research contributes to the development and realisation of its objectives while fostering dialogue with their own specialised field of inquiry. In this manner, the candidate will broaden their professional and research horizons and acquire additional knowledge and skills that will substantially contribute to the preparation of the doctoral dissertation.

Preference will be given to candidates who have completed a degree in philosophy at at least one level of study (BA or MA), or whose completion of a Master's degree is anticipated before the end of the current academic year. Knowledge of any of the relevant Asian languages in which foundational philosophical texts are composed is not a formal requirement at the time of appointment; however, the candidate will be expected to acquire a basic command of one relevant language during the period of employment. The candidate must demonstrate a high level of proficiency in both written and spoken Slovenian and English.

The candidate is also expected to demonstrate:

- strong organisational and communication skills,
- the ability to work effectively as part of a team,
- perseverance and a strong sense of responsibility,

Izobraževanje MR bo potekalo na področju razvojne in pedagoške psihologije. MR bo sodeloval_a pri načrtovanju, izvajanju in analizi prečnih in vzdolžnih raziskav na področju uporabe, dejavnikov in vplivov digitalne tehnologije na psihosocialno delovanje posameznikov v različnih življenjskih obdobjih. Posebej se bo osredotočil_a na omenjene fenomene v obdobju mladostništva in prehoda v odraslost, in sicer na normativne in ranljive skupine mladih, povezanost rabe digitalne tehnologije z duševnim zdravjem in vedenjem v medosebnih odnosih, različne socialne in individualne dejavnike prekomerne rabe interneta in uporabo spletnih izobraževalnih aplikacij in orodij genUI v izobraževanju. Eng.: The Young Researcher (YR) will join the research program Applied Developmental Psychology (P5-0062), conducted at the Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana. The YR's training will take place in the fields of developmental and educational psychology. The YR will participate in the design, implementation, and analysis of

cross-sectional and longitudinal studies focusing on the use, determinants, and effects of digital technology on individuals' psychosocial functioning across different life periods.

Particular emphasis will be placed on these phenomena during adolescence and emerging adulthood, including both normative and vulnerable groups of young people, the association between digital technology use and mental health as well as interpersonal behavior, various social and individual factors of excessive internet use, and the use of online educational applications and genUI tools in education. The specific topic of the doctoral dissertation will be defined in collaboration with the YR, taking into account their specific research interests. In accordance with the needs, the YR will also participate in teaching activities.

We invite applications from candidates who have completed a Master's degree in Psychology. Candidates who will complete their Master's degree in Psychology by September may also apply. Prior research experience is desirable, as well as background knowledge in the areas of digital technology, mental health and lifespan development, online educational applications and genUI tools in education. Knowledge of multivariate statistical methods, Excel, and the R programming language is also required.

Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate:

- a high level of motivation for research work, as well as for presenting and publishing scientific findings,

Slov.: Usposabljanje mladega raziskovalca bo potekalo na interdisciplinarnem področju kognitivne nevroznanosti s poudarkom na vsebinskih področjih delovnega spomina, kognitivnega nadzora, čustvenega procesiranja, individualnih razlik in psihopatologije ter z možnostjo vključevanja v raziskovalno delo na drugih povezanih področjih, npr. uporabna kognitivna psihologija, nevrofenomenologija. Mladi raziskovalec bo sodeloval pri načrtovanju in izvedbi vedenjskih, EEG in fMR študij ter pri razvoju analitičnih orodij za analizo multimodalnih podatkov slikanja možganov s poudarkom na preučevanju funkcijske konektivnosti. Zaželjene so izkušnje ali predznanje z vsebinskih področij kognitivne nevroznanosti (psihologije, kognitivne znanosti, nevrobiologije) in/ali metodoloških področij statistične analize podatkov, analize omrežij, procesiranja signalov, strojnega učenja in programiranja. Dobrodošle so raziskovalne izkušnje na področju eksperimentalne kognitivne psihologije, poznavanje EEG in fMR, znanje programskih jezikov Matlab, python in R ter izkušnje z uporabo unix/posix operacijskega sistema. Eng.: Candidate will train in the interdisciplinary field of cognitive neuroscience with emphasis on research on working memory, cognitive control, emotional processing, individual differences, and psychopathology, with possible integration with work in other related fields, e.g. applied cognitive psychology, neurophenomenology. The candidate will participate in planning and data collection of behavioral, EEG and fMRI studies, as well as development of analytical tools for analysis of multimodal neuroimaging data with emphasis on the study of functional connectivity. Experience or knowledge of the disciplines of cognitive neuroscience (psychology, cognitive science, neurobiology) and/or methodological areas of statistical data analysis, network analysis, signal processing, machine learning, and programming is desired. Experience with research in experimental cognitive psychology, familiarity with EEG and fMRI, programming languages Matlab, python, and R, and experience with use of unix/posix operating system is welcome. Candidates that demonstrate the desire and capability of independent research work as well as fruitful collaboration within an interdisciplinary team will be preferred. Slov.: Železnice, (avto)ceste, kolesarske poti, vodovodi, oddajniki ter električna ali telekomunikacijska omrežja niso zgolj fizični pojavi, temveč relacijske formacije, v katerih se prepletajo materiali, znanja, standardi, institucije, vrednote, percepcije preteklosti in prihodnosti ter uporabniške prakse. Infrastrukture delujejo kot materialne artikulacije imaginarijev, ideologij in družbenega življenja, zato so primerno mesto za analizo politike, ekonomije in vsakdanjosti (Anand).

Infrastrukturno-razvojne projekte preučujemo skozi ekspertne prakse merjenja, kartiranja, standardizacije in modeliranja, ki naredijo prostor berljiv na specifičen (reduciran) način, uporabljajo posebne tehnologije za preoblikovanje prostora, koordinirajo množico delavcev in dobaviteljev, materializirajo državnost – in sprožajo tudi nepredvidljive družbene učinke. K infrastrukturi pristopamo kot sociotehničnemu sklopu, s humanistično kritiko modernističnih poenostavitev in poudarjanjem potrebe po situiranem (lokalnem) znanju in umeščanju ekspertiz (Harvey & Knox, Scott, Haraway, Mitchell).

Temeljna raziskovalna vprašanja so: kako infrastrukturni projekti preurejajo razmerja med državo, strokovnjaki in prebivalci (politike prostora in razvoja)? Kako se generične tehnične rešitve prevajajo v situirane prakse in s kakšnimi nepredvidljivimi učinki (aproksimativnost menedžmenta)? Kako izkušnje in spomini preteklih infrastrukturnih projektov strukturirajo razmišljanje in prakse v sedanjosti – in prihodnosti (temporalnost)?

Raziskovalni projekt sloni na večlokacijskem etnografskem pristopu v Sloveniji ali tujini (Mediteran). Združuje opazovanje z udeležbo, polstrukturirane intervjuje z lokalnim prebivalstvom, uporabniki, strokovnjaki in odločevalci, sledenje dokumentom (standardi, študije izvedljivosti, projektna dokumentacija, javne razgrnitve in pripombe), ter analizo zgodovinskih in medijskih arhivov.

Rezultat projekta bodo teoretski prispevki k antropologiji infrastrukture posredno pa tudi priporočila za oblikovanje politik in projektov, ki v večji meri upoštevajo lokalna znanja in človeško materialno heterogenost.

Od kandidata za mladega raziskovalca pričakujemo, da znotraj raziskovalnega področja antropologija infrastrukture pripravi predlog doktorske raziskave, ki ga bo pozneje razvil v sodelovanju z mentorjem. Raziskovalno usposabljanje bo potekalo v okviru doktorskega študijskega programa *Etnologija, kulturna in socialna antropologija* in programske skupine *Etnološke raziskave kulturnih znanj, praks in oblik socialnosti*. Mladi raziskovalec/-ka bo poleg študija izvajal/-a vaje na programih 1. in 2. stopnje. Usposabljanje predvideva še etnografsko raziskovalno delo v tujini in doma, daljšo mednarodno izmenjavo ter predstavitev raziskovalnega dela v znanstvenih publikacijah in na konferencah.

Eng.: Railways, motorways, bicycle paths, water supply systems, digital transmitters, and electricity or telecommunications networks are not merely physical phenomena, but relational formations in which materials, knowledge, standards, institutions, values, futures, and user practices are intertwined. Infrastructures serve as material articulations of imaginaries, ideologies, and social life, and are therefore an appropriate site for the analysis of politics, economics, and everyday life (Anand).

Infrastructure and development projects are studied through expert practices of measurement, mapping, standardisation, and modelling, which render space readable in a specific (reduced) way, employ specialised technologies to transform space, coordinate numerous workers and suppliers, materialise statehood, and also trigger unpredictable social effects. We approach infrastructure as a sociotechnical phenomenon, with a humanistic critique of modernist simplifications and an emphasis on the need for situated (local) knowledge and the contextualisation of expertise (Harvey & Knox, Scott, Haraway, Mitchell).

The fundamental research questions are: how do infrastructure projects rearrange the relations between the state, experts, and residents (spatial and development policies)? How are generic technical solutions translated into situated practices, and with what unpredictable effects (approximation of management)? How do the experiences and memories of past infrastructure projects structure thinking and practices in the present and the future (temporality)?

The research project is based on a multi-sited ethnographic approach in Slovenia or abroad (Mediterranean). It combines observation and participation, semi-structured interviews with local residents, users, experts, and decision-makers, document tracking (standards, feasibility studies, project documentation, public disclosures and comments), and analysis of historical and media archives.

The result of the project will be theoretical contributions to the anthropology of infrastructure, as well as, indirectly, recommendations for the formulation of policies and projects that take greater account of local knowledge and human material heterogeneity.

A candidate for a young researcher is expected to prepare a doctoral research proposal within the research field of Anthropology of Infrastructure, which will later be developed in collaboration with the mentor. The research training will take place within the framework of the doctoral study programme *Ethnology, Cultural and Social Anthropology* and the programme group *Ethnological Research of Cultural Knowledge, Practices and Forms of Sociality*. In addition to his/her studies, the young researcher will carry out exercises in the 1st and 2nd level programmes. The training also envisages ethnographic research work abroad and at home, a longer international exchange and presentations of research work in scientific publications and conferences.

Pri tem se postavlja tudi pomembno vprašanje z vidika kakovosti, stroškovne učinkovitosti in prihranka časa pri vsebinski obdelavi.

Glede na nova pravila RDA, ki temeljijo na entitetno-relacijskem modelu IFLA-LRM, se bo proučevalo stanje na področju katalogizacije in vsebinske obdelave, s poudarkom na možnostih za evalvacijo kakovosti ter potrebah po bolj dosledni katalogizaciji. The candidate will be required to enrol in a doctoral programme and complete it within the prescribed timeframe. The topic of the doctoral dissertation will relate to library science, particularly descriptive and subject cataloguing.

The young researcher will address content processing from the perspective of a cataloguer (cataloguing theory and practice; the usefulness of thesauri and classification schemes, internal rules, and subjectivity) and from the perspective of library catalogue users (user tasks, retrieval and accuracy, effectiveness, and user understanding of bibliographic data for content processing). The work process of cataloguers and the user perspective will be studied. Content processing offers significant opportunities for the integration of artificial intelligence, which Slovenian cataloguers do not yet have at their disposal. This raises the question of whether systems that suggest subject and classification labels, which are then confirmed, rejected, or supplemented by humans, would function effectively in the Slovenian context. It also raises important questions regarding quality, cost efficiency, and time savings in content processing.

In view of the new RDA rules, which are based on the IFLA-LRM entity-relationship model, the situation in cataloguing and content processing will be examined, with an emphasis on the possibilities for evaluating quality and the need for more consistent cataloguing. A model will need to be developed to measure the effectiveness and impact of cataloguing rules and the assignment of subject and classification codes. This also raises questions related to the diversity of subject codes for different user groups and communities.

The details of the topic and training will be defined in collaboration with the young researcher, considering their specific research and professional interests. In addition to completing their doctoral studies, at the end of the training, the young researcher will acquire the knowledge required for independent scientific research and experience in teaching at higher education institutions in the field of library science.

Candidates are expected to be proficient in oral and written communication in Slovenian and English.

The young researcher (YR) will conduct research at the Department of Psychology, Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana. The YR will participate in the research programme P5-0110 Psychological and Neuroscientific Aspects of Cognition. The research will be situated at the intersection of cognitive psychology and personality psychology, with a particular focus on examining the role of cognitive processes in the regulation of behaviour in everyday life. These processes include mechanisms of cognitive control that enable flexible information processing and the adjustment of behaviour to the individual's current goals and environmental demands.

The research will focus on the study of behavioural regulation in everyday life, particularly in situations where individuals act in ways that are inconsistent with their stable personality dispositions (counterdispositional behaviour). Previous research suggests that such behaviour is often associated with increased cognitive-regulatory effort and various emotional consequences; however, empirical findings regarding these effects remain inconsistent. The research will therefore broadly aim to advance understanding of the factors involved in behavioural regulation in everyday life and their short- and long-term emotional outcomes. The specific research programme will be defined in more detail in agreement with the selected candidate, taking into account their competences and specific research interests.

The candidate is expected to enrol in and successfully complete the doctoral programme Personality Psychology within the interdisciplinary doctoral study programme Humanities and Social Sciences at the Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana.
