Mladi raziskovalec bo vključen v raziskovalno delo programske skupine Slovenska zgodovina (P6-0235), kar mu bo omogočalo dostop do raziskovalne infrastrukture Univerze v Ljubljani. V skladu z raziskovalnimi izhodišči programske skupine bo delo mladega raziskovalca osredotočeno na raziskovanje zgodovinskih fenomenov, procesov in/ali posameznikov. Časovni okvir njegovega dela bo predstavljalo obdobje antike, predvsem čas rimskega cesarstva. Zaradi vpetosti današnjega slovenskega prostora v širši prostor rimskega cesarstva v tistem času bo geografski okvir njegovih raziskav segal preko meja današnjega slovenskega prostora in zajemal tudi širše balkansko-podonavsko področje. Njegova naloga bo na osnovi zgodovinskih virov predstaviti zgodovinske fenomene, procese in/ali posameznike v izbranem prostoru in času ter jih umestiti v širši kontekst istočasnega dogajanja na področju rimskega cesarstva, s tem pa hkrati prikazati vpetost izbranega prostora v razvojne procese na družbenem, kulturnem, političnem, religioznom in/ali gospodarskem področju ozemlja takratne Evrope, Bližnjega Vzhoda in severne Afrike.

Kandidat bo svoje raziskovalne rezultate sproti predstavljal slovenski in mednarodni znanstveni javnosti.

The young researcher will be involved in the research work of the Slovenian History program group (P6-0235), which will give him or her access to the research infrastructure of the University of Ljubljana. In accordance with the research approaches of the program group, the work of the young researcher will focus on the study of historical phenomena, processes and/or individuals. The time frame of his or her work will be the period of antiquity, especially during the time of the Roman Empire. Due to the integration of today's Slovenian territory into the larger area of the Roman Empire, the geographical scope of the research will extend beyond the borders of today's Slovenian territory and also include the wider Balkan-Danubian region. The task of the researcher will be to analyze and present historical phenomena, processes, and/or individuals in the selected area and period on the basis of historical sources and to place them in the broader context of contemporaneous events within the Roman Empire. In this way, the researcher will demonstrate the integration of the selected area into the development processes in the social, cultural, political, religious and/or economic spheres of Europe, the Near East and North Africa at that time.

The candidate will present his/her research results to the Slovenian and international scientific public.

In addition to the general requirements, the young researcher candidate is expected to:

- be highly motivated for scientific research work
- be proactive, creative, and persistent
- be capable of independent critical and analytical thinking
- be communicative and able to work both independently and as part of a team
- have knowledge of Latin and Ancient Greek

*Slov.:***Opis raziskovalnega dela in cilj raziskave:**

Raziskovalno mesto mladega raziskovalca je usmerjeno v interdisciplinarno preučevanje grobišč bronaste in starejše železne dobe na območju Slovenije in širšega prostora med Alpami in Panonijo. Kandidat bo povezoval arheološke podatke z izbranih grobišč s podatki iz antropoloških raziskav ter rezultati sodobnih naravoslovnih analiz, kot so stabilni izotopi (C, N, S, O, Sr) in ATR-FTIR spektroskopija. Tako bo z analizo materialne kulture in rezultatov naravoslovnih analiz pridobil boljši vpogled v pogrebne običaje, demografsko sliko, prehranjevalne navade, mobilnost oz. migracij itn., s tem pa poglobil razumevanje skupnosti in družbenih sprememb (npr. spremembe pogrebnih običajev – inhumacija/kremacija) v tem obdobju.

Ključne naloge:

1. **Analiza obstoječih podatkov:** Pregled, sinteza in analiza obstoječih arheoloških in antropoloških podatkov z izbranih grobišč z območja Slovenije iz bronaste in železne dobe.
2. **Izotopske analize:** Dopolnitev obstoječih rezultatov izotopskih analiz na posmrtnih ostankih ljudi in živali. Trenutno je bilo uspešno analiziranih preko 800 vzorcev (361 odvezetih iz posmrtnih ostankov ljudi in 240 iz posmrtnih ostankov živali), večje število vzorcev pa je še v analizah. Hkrati je bilo analizirano tudi rastlinje na preko 200 lokacijah v Sloveniji, kar bo omogočilo izdelavo izotopske karte stroncija (priprava karte je v zaključni fazи in bo na razpolago).
3. **FTIR spektroskopija:** Uporaba ATR-FTIR za analizo sprememb v kemični sestavi kosti, povezanih z rituali pokopa (predvsem pri kremaciji). Podobno kot točka 3, je tudi tukaj že veliko obstoječih podatkov, ki bodo dopolnjeni.
4. **Statistične analize:** Za potrditev/ovržbo hipotez, modeliranje razmerij in preverjanjem veljavnosti podatkov ter odkrivanje skritih vzorcev, zakonitosti in nepričakovanih povezav v podatkih brez predhodnih hipotez.
5. **Povezovanje podatkov:** Sinteza podatkov iz različnih virov za oblikovanje čim bolj celovitih interpretacij.

Rezultati in doprinos:

- Prispevek k razumevanju družbe v bronasti in železni dobi.
- Prispevek k razumevanju odnosa skupnosti do družbenih (in okoljskih) sprememb v preteklosti.
- Razvoj orodij in pristopov, ki bodo uporabni tudi v drugih interdisciplinarnih arheoloških raziskavah.

Pridobljena znanja:

- Celostna analize grobišč in grobnih ritualov.
- Delo s podatkovnimi bazami, ki vključujejo različne vrste podatkov.
- Analize stabilnih izotopov: od vzorčenja do priprave vzorca za analize, analize in interpretacije podatkov.
- ATR-FTIR spektroskopija: od vzorčenja do priprave vzorca za analize, analize in interpretacije podatkov.
- Izvedba statističnih analiz.
- Povezovanje različnih vrst podatkov za potrebe celostne interpretacije.

Uspodbujanje in delovno okolje:

Mladi raziskovalec (MR) bo vključen v že obstoječe sodelovanje med Oddelkom za arheologijo FF UL, Institutom Jožef Stefan (IJS), Kemijskim inštitutom (KI) in Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB). To sodelovanje je vpeto v delo in raziskovalni razvoj naše programske skupine Arheologija (P6-0247), kot je bilo predvideno za naslednje obdobje.

Ob tem pa so razvoj naše programske skupine in njenih kapacitet ključni tudi nanjo vezani raziskovalni projekti, kot je projekt CRIME (Kremacija ali inhumacija pri preteklih skupnostih) ter nadaljnji načrtovani projekti, kot na primer TRAP (Transition, Resilience, and Adaptation in Prehistory). Oba projekta med drugim vključujejo povezovanje arheoloških in naravoslovnih podatkov, zato bo MR neposredno vpletен tako v aktivnosti programske skupine, kot tudi v projektno delo ter domače in mednarodno raziskovalno okolje. Hkrati bo vključen tudi v projekt MATRES (Materialna odpornost v časih okoljskih in družbenih sprememb), ki se pripravlja na razpisu za Velike interdisciplinarne projekte Univerze v Ljubljani, saj se raziskovalna tema neposredno navezuje tudi na vsebino projekta.

Poudariti velja, da bo MR pridobil v slovenski stroki trenutno manjkajoča znanja na presečišču arheologije in bioarheologije. Na IJS in VUB se bo izučil, kako pripraviti vzorce in izvesti analize izotopov, ter na KI, kako pripraviti vzorce in izvesti FTIR analize. Gre za analize, ki so v arheoloških interdisciplinarnih raziskavah zelo pogosto prisotne, zato je ključno, da se aktivno vključimo vanje tudi z vzugajanjem prihodnjih rodov raziskovalcev. Pri tem pa niso potrebna le (tehnična) naravoslovna znanja. Predvsem nam primanjkuje strokovnjakov, ki bi znali razumeti in smiselnovo povezovati arheološke in bioarheološke (vključno z izotopskimi) podatke, tako za interpretacijo kot tudi za načrtovanje raziskav in sodelovanje pri različnih interdisciplinarnih projektih.

Eng.:

Description of Research Work and Research Goal:

The research focus of the young researcher is aimed at the interdisciplinary study of burial sites from the Bronze and Early Iron Ages in Slovenia and the broader area between the Alps and Pannonia. The candidate will integrate archaeological data from selected burial sites with data from anthropological studies and results of modern natural science analyses, such as stable isotopes (C, N, S, O, Sr) and ATR-FTIR spectroscopy. By analyzing material culture and natural science results, the research will offer deeper insights into burial customs, demographic structures, dietary habits, mobility and migration, etc., thus enhancing the understanding of communities and societal changes (e.g., changes in burial practices—inhumation/cremation) during this period.

Key Tasks:

1. **Analysis of Existing Data:** Review, synthesis, and analysis of existing archaeological and anthropological data from selected burial sites in Slovenia from the Bronze and Iron Ages.
2. **Isotopic Analyses:** Supplementation of existing results from isotopic analyses of human and animal skeletal remains. To date, over 800 samples have been successfully analyzed (361 from human remains and 240 from animal remains), with a larger number of samples still under analysis. Additionally, plant remains from over 200 locations in Slovenia have been analyzed, allowing for the creation of a strontium isotopic map (the map is in the final stages and will be available).
3. **FTIR Spectroscopy:** Use of ATR-FTIR spectroscopy to analyze changes in the chemical composition of bones related to burial rituals (primarily cremation). As with point 3, there is already a significant body of existing data that will be supplemented.
4. **Statistical Analyses:** To confirm or refute hypotheses, model relationships, validate data, and uncover hidden patterns, regularities, and unexpected connections in the data without prior hypotheses.
5. **Data Integration:** Synthesis of data from different sources to form the most comprehensive interpretations possible.

Results and Contribution:

- Contribution to the understanding of society in the Bronze and Iron Ages.
- Contribution to the understanding of how communities responded to social (and environmental) changes in the past.
- Development of tools and approaches that will be useful in other interdisciplinary archaeological research.

Acquired Knowledge:

- Comprehensive analysis of burial sites and burial rituals.
- Work with databases that include various types of data.
- Stable isotope analysis: from sampling to sample preparation for analysis, data analysis, and interpretation.
- ATR-FTIR spectroscopy: from sampling to sample preparation for analysis, data analysis, and interpretation.
- Execution of statistical analyses.
- Integration of different data types for comprehensive interpretation.

Training and Work Environment:

The Young Researcher (YR) will be involved in the existing collaboration between the Department of Archaeology at the University of Ljubljana (FF UL), the Jožef Stefan Institute (IJS), the Chemistry Institute (KI), and the Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB). This collaboration is embedded in the work and research as well as development of our Archaeology research group (P6-0247), as planned for the upcoming period. In this context, the development of our research group and its capacities is also crucial for the associated research projects, such as the CRIME project (Cremation or Inhumation in Past Communities) and other planned projects, such as TRAP (Transition, Resilience, and Adaptation in Prehistory). Both projects, among other things, involve the integration of

archaeological and natural science data, so the YR will be directly involved in both the activities of the program group and the project work, as well as in the national and international research environment. At the same time, he/she will also be included in the MATRES project (Material Resilience in Times of Environmental and Social Changes), which is being prepared for the call for Large Interdisciplinary Projects at the University of Ljubljana, as the research topic is directly related to the project's content.

It is important to emphasize that the YR will acquire knowledge currently missing in the Slovenian field at the intersection of archaeology and bioarchaeology. At IJS and VUB, the YR will learn how to prepare samples and conduct isotope analyses, and at KI, how to prepare samples and perform FTIR analyses. These analyses are common in interdisciplinary archaeological research, making it essential to actively engage in them and train future generations of researchers. In this context, not only (technical) natural science knowledge is necessary. There is a particular shortage of experts who can understand and meaningfully connect archaeological and bioarchaeological (including isotopic) data, both for interpretation and for planning research and collaborating on various interdisciplinary projects.

Mladi raziskovalec se bo usposabljal na Oddelku za slavistiko, natančneje na Rusistiki. Kandidat mora imeti opravljen magistrski študij rusistike (2. bolonjska stopnja). Ukvajal se bo s prevodoslovnim raziskovanjem na področju ruske literature, pri čemer se bo med drugim lahko osredotočal na književno prevajanje iz ruščine v slovenščino, na zgodovino književnega prevajanja v ruski kulturi ali na zgodovino književnega prevajanja iz ruščine v slovenščino, na rusko prevodoslovno misel (tj. rusko teorijo prevajanja) in njen razvoj, posamezne avtorje oz. prevajalce v ruščino ali iz ruščine v slovenščino ali v tretji tuji jezik, če ga kandidat pozna, prevode posameznih del v ruščino ali iz ruščine v slovenščino ali v tretji tuji jezik, če ga kandidat pozna, ruske prevajalske šole in nenazadnje na prevajalska orodja za specifično rusko-slovensko jezikovno kombinacijo, kar vključuje tudi umetno inteligenco.

Obvezno je znanje ruskega in slovenskega jezika. Zaželeno je, da je z raziskovalnim področjem povezana tema magistrske naloge, s katero se kandidat prijavlja, kot tudi morebitne predhodne publikacije, ter da ima kandidat izkušnje s področja književnega prevajanja. Če se bo kandidat znotraj raziskovalnega področja usmeril v prevajalska orodja, je zaželeno tudi poznavanje upoštevnih orodij. Pričakuje se sposobnost in motiviranost za samostojno raziskovalno delo ter pripravljenost sodelovanja v morebitnih raziskovalnih projektih.

The young researcher position is to be filled at the Department of Slavistics, specifically Russian Studies. The candidate must have completed a master's degree in Russian studies (2nd Bologna cycle). Their research will focus on translation studies in the field of Russian literature, with possible areas of specialisation including literary translation from Russian to Slovene, the history of literary translation in Russian culture, the history of literary translation from Russian to Slovene, Russian translation theory and its development, specific authors or translators into or from Russian to Slovene or to a third foreign language if the candidate is proficient in one, translations of specific works into or from Russian to Slovene or a third foreign language if the candidate is proficient in one, Russian translation schools, and, last but not least, translation tools for the Russian-Slovene language combination, including artificial intelligence.

Proficiency in both Russian and Slovene is mandatory. It is desirable that the candidate's master's thesis topic aligns with the research field, along with any previous publications, and that the candidate has experience in the field of literary translation. If the candidate chooses to focus on translation tools, familiarity with relevant tools is also desirable. The candidate is expected to demonstrate the ability and motivation for independent research work and a willingness to participate in potential research projects.

Mlada raziskovalka oz. mladi raziskovalec se bo s svojim delom vključil v raziskovalni program Teoretično, opisno in uporabno prevodoslovje (P6-0446), ki se izvaja na Filozofski fakulteti univerze v Ljubljani, in sicer bo deloval na področju uporabnega in opisnega prevodoslovja. MR se bo posvetil raziskovanju prevajanja in tolmačenja v medicinskom okolju.

Ključni cilji raziskave mlade raziskovalke oz. mladega raziskovalca (MR) bodo ugotoviti, kakšne so značilnosti prevodnega polja, v okviru katerega poteka sodobno prevajanje in tolmačenje za potrebe zdravstva na Slovenskem, določiti akterje, ki delujejo na področju prevajanja in tolmačenja za potrebe zdravstva na Slovenskem ter prek študij uporabnosti kritično ovrednotiti rabo strojnih prevajalnikov in digitalnih orodij za vzpostavitev večjezične komunikacije v zdravstvu.

Predlagana raziskovalna tema torej implicira interdisciplinarno širitev tradicionalno razumljenega fokusa prevodoslovnega raziskovanja in predvideva, da se bo MR v svoji raziskavi moral seznaniti metodološkimi pristopi, značilnimi za sociološke študije, in s študijami uporabnosti, ki so se pod vplivom različnih raziskovalcev razvile in preoblikovale v prevodoslovju.

The young researcher will join the research programme Theoretical, Descriptive and Applied Translation Studies (P6-0446), functioning within the Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana, and will work in the field of applied and descriptive translation studies, in particular, the young researcher will focus on translational research in a healthcare setting.

The key objectives of the young researcher's work will be to identify the characteristics of the translation field within which contemporary healthcare translation and interpreting take place in Slovenia, to identify the agents working in the field of healthcare translation and interpreting in Slovenia, and by carrying out usability studies to critically evaluate the use of machine translation and other digital tools used for multilingual communication in healthcare settings in Slovenia.

The proposed research topic therefore implies an interdisciplinary broadening of the traditionally understood focus of translation studies methodology, and assumes that the young researcher will have to become familiar with methodological approaches developed within sociology, and with usability studies that have been further developed and adapted within translational research.

Slov.: V okviru uporabnega in opisnega prevodoslova se bo mladi raziskovalec/mlada raziskovalka osredotočil/a na raziskovanje literarnega prevajanja in literarnih prevajalcev ter drugih akterjev v kontekstu zamejskih Slovencev v Italiji. Poglavitni cilji raziskave MR bodo ugotoviti, kakšno vlogo je imel oz. ima prevod v okolju Slovencev v Italiji, vlogo prevajalcev kot kulturnih posrednikov, dinamiko prevajalskih mrež ter vpliv družbenih norm in ideologij na prevajalske odločitve, zlasti na primeru prevajanja literarnih del za dramsko uprizarjanje.

Raziskovalna tema je zastavljena interdisciplinarno, saj tradicionalno področje prevodoslova povezuje z zgodovinskimi in sociološkimi pristopi, kar pomeni, da bo pri svojem delu MR uporabljal metode, tipične za sociološke in zgodovinske raziskave, tako kot so jih v svojem delu utemeljili predhodni raziskovalci v prevodoslovju. Prednost bodo torej imeli kandidati, ki:

- imajo dokončano izobrazbo iz prevajanja ali tolmačenja;
- imajo povezave z zamejsko slovensko skupnostjo v Italiji;
- imajo izkušnje z raziskovanjem literarnega prevajanja za dramsko uprizarjanje.
