



Application periods

CANDIDATES OF EU MEMBER STATES & SLOVENIANS ABROAD

The first application period:
18 February - 18 March 2026

The second application period:
20 August - 27 August 2026

- Candidates who did not apply in the first-round application period.
- Candidates who have not been admitted into any of the degree programmes specified in the first-round application.
- Candidates who have not enrolled in the degree programme to which they have been admitted in the first-round application period.
- Candidates who have deregistered from a degree programme by 14 August 2026 inclusive.

The application period for still available enrolment slots:
23 September - 24 September 2026 until 10 am

- Candidates who did not apply in the first or the second application period,
- Candidates who submitted their first or second application and were not admitted to any of the study programs listed in the application in the current year's selection process
- Candidates who were not admitted to any degree program in the first or the second application period,
- Candidate who were admitted to the degree program that will not be implemented.

CANDIDATES OF NON EU COUNTRIES

The first application period:
18 February - 18 March 2026

The second application period:

2 September - 3 September 2026 (The admission procedure is run by the faculties and academies which announce available enrolment slots.)

- a decision on the recognition of foreign education issued in the first application period at the University of Ljubljana this year and are not enrolled after the selection procedure in the first application period,
- a decision on the recognition of foreign secondary educational qualifications issued before 2005,
- finished secondary school in SFRY before 25 June 1991,
- the International Baccalaureate Diploma or the European Baccalaureate Certificate,
- a decision on the recognition of foreign secondary education issued by other universities and independent higher education institutions in Slovenia with permanent validity.

Citizens from **non-EU countries, who have completed their high school education in the Republic of Slovenia** and have final certification of high school in Slovenia (**MATURA**) can also apply for **SLO/EU enrollment places**. These students **do not pay tuition fees for fulltime studies** (even if there is no agreement between the two countries). This **does not apply** to persons **who have completed an international high school** in the Republic of Slovenia, and they must go through the process of recognizing foreign high school education.

Bachelor's and Single Cycle Master's Degree Programmes

- In the application, in order of preference, the candidates can indicate a maximum of three different degree programmes into which they wish to enrol and for which they meet the enrolment conditions.
- The order the degree programmes are written down is important: the candidates will be placed in the first one for which they meet the enrolment conditions.
- Lectures are public.

Bachelor's and Single Cycle Master's Degree Programmes in English

The most courses are conducted in Slovenian.

Lessons are held in English at the **UL School of Economics and Business** (University degree programme Business and Economics) – **it is offered in both Slovene and English within full-time studies.** For the application period for Slovene citizens and EU citizens, only the Slovene version of the programme will be available in the eVŠ system for both full-time and part-time studies. For the application period for Slovenians abroad and for citizens of non-EU countries, applicants to full-time studies will be able to choose between the Slovene and English versions, while part-time studies will be available only in Slovene.

Recognition of foreign secondary education

WHO NEEDS RECOGNITION OF EDUCATION?

Recognition of education is required for applicants with a foreign education certificate who wish to continue their studies in Slovenia.

HOW TO APPLY FOR IT?

For applicants with foreign qualifications, the electronic enrolment application on the eVŠ web portal is also an application for recognition for access to education in the Republic of Slovenia.

How do I submit the required documents?

- All required documents have to be **attached through the eVŠ web portal electronically** as scans or photographs of the original certificates
 - and other documents!
- **Applicant may submit on the eVŠ portal a maximum of 3 attachments per evidence and a maximum size of 5 MB per attachment.**
- Candidates send translations only on the request, received on the web portal eVŠ.

Evidence of completed foreign education to be enclosed to the application for enrolment and recognition

Required documents

1. E-copy/scan of the **final education certificate** representing general requirement for access to higher education in the country of issue without legalization.

A copy shall be verified by the issuing institution at the request of the University of Ljubljana.

If the higher education institution is unable to verify the authenticity of the document, applicants will be asked to send original of the **final education certificate**. Legalization is not required for the Republic of Austria due to a bilateral agreement.

2. E-copy/scan of a **Slovene (or English) translation of an education certificate** referred to in item 1. If a certified translation of the certificate(s) is required, the applicant will be asked for it subsequently on the web portal eVS.

3. E-copies/scans of **annual report cards**, transcripts, diploma supplement or other evidence on the contents and duration of education (for all years of pre-university education) and translation into Slovene (or English) language for the last two years of education. If a certified translation of the certificate(s) is required, the applicant will be asked for it subsequently on the web portal eVS.

4. E-copy/scan of **short chronological description** of the entire education, relevant to the enrolment application and recognition procedure of foreign education, prepared by the applicant himself/herself, stating prior education including the schools attended, dates of attendance, possible transfers, accelerated progress, repletion of courses, extended student status, and similar. 5. E-copy/scan of the evidence of the **Slovene language examination at level B2** or equivalent – if required for enrolment to individual programme.

6. E-copy/scan of **ID document**:

- EU Member state citizens: a page of the identity card or passport with the applicant's details (showing name, surname, date and place of birth, and nationality),
- non-EU Member state citizens: a page of passport with the applicant's details (showing name, surname, date and place of birth, and nationality).

7. Other evidence: The education recognition body may request that the applicant encloses additional evidence.

Interview for applicants from countries with a higher migration risk

- Applicants who are citizens of countries with a **higher migration risk** and who **require visas to cross the European Union external borders**, must undergo a **direct interview** on their suitability for enrolment in the degree programme in accordance with the enrolment conditions before further professional and administrative consideration.
- Candidates will receive more detailed information about the interview from higher education institutions after the application deadline.



Decision on recognition

- Once the recognition procedure is completed, a recognition decision is issued to the applicant with decision on his/her right to access, apply and be considered for admission to further education into bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes.
- The decision is delivered to the applicant via the eVŠ web portal.

Evidence of the Slovene language Examination – Bachelor's and Single Cycle Master's Degree Programmes

- Candidates have to attach the evidence of the Slovenian language examination – Level B2 on the eVŠ web portal by the required deadline (if it is so required by a degree programme).
- Candidates can pass the Slovenian language exam in Slovenia or abroad.

How do I submit required documents and what documents are needed for enrollment?

Evidence of completed foreign education to be enclosed to the application for enrolment and recognition

Required documents

1. E-copy/scan of the **final education certificate** representing general requirement for access to higher education in the country of issue without legalization.

A copy shall be verified by the issuing institution at the request of the University of Ljubljana.

If the higher education institution is unable to verify the authenticity of the document, applicants will be asked to send original of the **final education certificate**. Legalization is not required for the Republic of Austria due to a bilateral agreement.

2. E-copy/scan of a **Slovene (or English) translation of an education certificate** referred to in item 1. If a certified translation of the certificate(s) is required, the applicant will be asked for it subsequently on the web portal eVS.

3. E-copies/scans of **annual report cards**, transcripts, diploma supplement or other evidence on the contents and duration of education (for all years of pre-university education) and translation into Slovene (or English) language for the last two years of education. If a certified translation of the certificate(s) is required, the applicant will be asked for it subsequently on the web portal eVS.

4. E-copy/scan of **short chronological description** of the entire education, relevant to the enrolment application and recognition procedure of foreign education, prepared by the applicant himself/herself, stating prior education including the schools attended, dates of attendance, possible transfers, accelerated progress, repletion of courses, extended student status, and similar. 5. E-copy/scan of the evidence of the **Slovene language examination at level B2** or equivalent – if required for enrolment to individual programme.

6. E-copy/scan of **ID document**:

- EU Member state citizens: a page of the identity card or passport with the applicant's details (showing name, surname, date and place of birth, and nationality),
- non-EU Member state citizens: a page of passport with the applicant's details (showing name, surname, date and place of birth, and nationality).

7. Other evidence: The education recognition body may request that the applicant encloses additional evidence.

How do I submit the required documents?

- All required documents have to be **attached through the eVŠ web portal electronically** as scans or photographs of the original certificates
 - and other documents!
- **Applicant may submit on the eVŠ portal a maximum of 3 attachments per evidence and a maximum size of 5 MB per attachment.**
- Candidates send translations only on the request, received on the web portal eVŠ.

Evidence of the Slovene language Examination – Bachelor's and Single Cycle Master's Degree Programmes

- Candidates have to attach the evidence of the Slovenian language examination – Level B2 on the eVŠ web portal by the required deadline (if it is so required by a degree programme).
- Candidates can pass the Slovenian language exam in Slovenia or abroad.
- For the **UL Faculty of Medicine** at ALTE - approved Slovenian Language Examination Centres; **You can only take the Slovenian exam at the UL Faculty of Arts, Center for Slovenian as a Second/Foreign Language.**

I would like to know what my chances are of getting accepted, and how it is calculated and determined?

- 60%-general success in the final exam, vocational matriculation or general matriculation and 40% general success in 3rd and 4th year
- If you need a test of ability, capacity and skills for enrollment, it is calculated differently. Check the Call for enrollment.

Slovenian language

- It is intended for international students in their first study year at the University of Ljubljana bachelor or master degree programmes.
- Students can apply for the Year Plus if they enroll in the University of Ljubljana with the citizenship of their country of origin.
- *Year plus is not designed for candidates applying for studies that require the knowledge of Slovenian at B2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).*

Year plus enables learning Slovene for free to help international students to adapt to the Slovenian system and culture.

To be eligible for Year Plus, a student must be enrolled in one of the degree programmes at the University of Ljubljana. Learning Slovene takes place simultaneously with the fulfillment of study obligations in the study program.

- The procedure for the recognition of foreign education begins with the application for enrolment at the University of Ljubljana. For applicants with a foreign qualification, the application form also serves as an application for recognition of education for the purpose of continuing education. This procedure is conducted by an authorised person at the university to which the applicant is applying to study under their first preference.

Is it possible to apply to three faculties at different universities in one application for university? If a candidate has applied with 2 applications on 2 universities, is it possible to be accepted on both? If the answer is yes, what is the next step?

- It is possible-then, you choose where you wish to enroll.
- **EU citizens can submit only one application in the first period**, and non-EU citizens can submit **several applications**, for each university/independent institution its own application.

Is passing a centralised English exam after finishing school in my country and having English lessons at school a proof of English level for studying at university or do I have to take an additional international English exam? Is Duolingo accepted?

- a certificate of passing an English language exam at level B2 or an equivalent certificate (e.g. TOEFL iBT score of 72-93),
- a secondary school certificate (Matura), which shows that the foreign language English was passed at the final examination (general or vocational);
- a certificate of completion of secondary education, which was conducted in English.

Do I have to have the required documents translated beforehand for the application or will they be translated by the university if necessary?

- **If a certified translation of the document(s) is required, the applicant will be asked for it subsequently on the web portal eVŠ.**
- If you come from one of the countries of the former Yugoslavia and have documents in the Latin alphabet, it is very likely that you will not need translations. If the documents are in Cyrillic, we advise you to translate them into Slovenian or English.
- If you have original documents in English, a translation is not required.

What happens if more applicants than the number of admitted students have perfect grades?

If you all have 100/100, you are all accepted.

What is the procedure for the recognition of the IB Diploma and of which grades must the transcripts be submitted?

- According to the Matura Act, the International Baccalaureate Diploma is equivalent to the general Matura certificate in the Republic of Slovenia without a recognition procedure. Candidates who receive the IB certificate must complete the recognition procedure in order to continue their education.
- You do not need to wait for the physical diploma to be issued, you can attach an electronic transcript from your organization –just the IB diploma, you do not need to attach grades.
