

TIMELINE of the application and admission procedure for enrolment into bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes of the University of Ljubljana in the academic year 2026/2027 for foreign citizens of non-EU member states

First application period (Higher Education Application and Information Service – VPIS UL)

Application for enrolment

Between **18 February - 18 March 2026** applicants apply for enrolment into the first year of bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes by submitting an electronic application form.

Information day

On **13 and 14 February 2026** the information days for undergraduate studies will take place at the academies and faculties.

Documents for enrolment and recognition of foreign education

Applicants must submit all supporting documents, listed in Annex 4 of the Call for Enrolment.

Applicants who will be completing their secondary education this year will have to submit all supporting documents by **31 July 2026**, in accordance with the request for completion of the application.

Applicants whose final certificate will be issued after **31 July 2026** and whose decision on the recognition of the education will be issued by **21 August 2026** will also be included in the selection procedure.

Applicants who have already completed secondary education at the time of application and who already have final certificate(s) must submit it to the electronic application by the end of the application period, by **18 March 2026**. Other evidence of having fulfilled the entry requirements (e.g. a certificate of having passed the B2 level Slovenian language exam) must be submitted by **31 July 2026** at the latest.

Interview for applicants from countries with a higher migration risk

Applicants who are citizens of countries with a higher migration risk and who require visas to cross the European Union external borders, must undergo a direct interview on their suitability for enrolment in the degree programme in accordance with the enrolment conditions before further professional and administrative consideration.

Candidates will receive more detailed information about the interview from higher education institutions after the application deadline.

Tests of ability, capacity, and skills

The tests will be held **from 24 June to 8 July 2026** at academies and faculties, which will send to candidates a notice of the date and schedule of the tests at least five days before the test.

Number of applications

On **25 March 2026**, data on the number of applications for each degree programme will be published on the website of the University of Ljubljana.

Enrolment limitation

On **25 March 2026**, information about the enrolment limit will be published on the website of the University of Ljubljana.

If the number of applicants listed first in the applications for enrolment into bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes exceeds 10 percent or more of enrolment slots available, an enrolment limitation shall be set for those degree programmes.

Selection procedure

The Higher Education Application and Information Service will carry out the selection procedure for applicants for enrolment no later than **25 and 26 August 2026**.

Results of the selection procedure

All the applicants with a valid application will be notified of the results of the selection procedure (the decision is published in their electronic application) by **28 August 2026**.

Appeal deadline

The final deadline for appeals is 21 days after receiving the decision on the selection procedure. The Ljubljana University Appeals Committee for Applicants for Admission to the University will decide on any appeal.

Second application period (at academies and faculties of the university)

Application for enrolment

In the second application period, on **2 and 3 September 2026**, applicants who have a decision on the recognition of foreign education issued in the first application period at the University of Ljubljana this year and are not enrolled after the selection procedure in the first application period, may apply for the still vacant enrolment slots.

In addition to these, applicants who meet one of the following conditions may also apply:

- who have a decision on the recognition of foreign secondary education issued before 2005,
- who have an International Baccalaureate or European Baccalaureate Diploma,
- who completed secondary education in the SFRY before 25 June 1991,
- who have a decision on the recognition of foreign secondary education issued by other universities and independent higher education institutions in Slovenia with permanent validity.

Applicants apply for enrolment into the first year of bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes by submitting an electronic application form together with supporting documents, in accordance with the terms of the call for enrolment.

If the number of applicants listed first in the second application period for enrolment into bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes exceeds the number of enrolment slots available, applicants shall be selected based on the selection criteria specified in case of enrolment limitation in the degree programme.

Interview for applicants from countries with a higher migration risk

Applicants who are citizens of countries with a higher migration risk and who require visas to cross the European Union external borders, must undergo a direct interview on their suitability for enrolment in the degree programme in accordance with the enrolment conditions before further professional and administrative consideration.

Candidates will receive more detailed information about the interview from higher education institutions after the application deadline.

Enrolment for accepted applicants

Up until **30 September 2026** applicants who have been accepted in the first or the second selection procedures may enrol at the faculty or academy on the basis of the decision on the result of the selection procedure.
