



In accordance with the constitutionally guaranteed autonomy of the University and pursuant to the Higher Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 32/12 – official consolidated version, 40/12 – ZUJF, 57/12 – ZPCP-2D, 109/12, 85/14, 75/16, 61/17 – ZUPŠ and 65/17) and the Order on the reorganisation of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 28/00, 33/03, 79/04, 36/06, 18/09, 83/10 and 8/19) the Senate of the University of Ljubljana at its session of 16 June 2020 and the Governing Board of the University of Ljubljana at its session of 16 July 2020 adopted the following

Amendments to the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana

1. Article 1

In the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 4/17, 56/17, 56/17, 14/18, 39/18, 57/18, 66/18, 10/19, 22/19, 36/19 and 47/19) Article 149 shall be amended to read:

“The procedure of appointment to the title of higher education teacher, scientific worker and research associate is initiated at the request of the candidate seeking appointment.

The candidate must file a written application at the member institution which is responsible for the habilitation field in which the candidate seeks to be appointed.

When more than one member institution is responsible for a field of habilitation, the candidate may file the application for appointment at any one of them. In such cases, the member institutions that are responsible for the habilitation field in question reach an agreement on the appointment of referees who will assess the candidate’s professional or artistic competence.

If the candidate is not employed at the University, they must enclose a declaration by the Senate of the member institution responsible for the field in which the candidate seeks habilitation (home member institution) stating that the University is interested in collaborating with the candidate and thus in the implementation of the appointment procedure. If the interest is shown by a member institution that is not responsible for the field in which the candidate seeks habilitation, the Senate of this member institution must provide a declaration to the home member institution’s Senate stating that the University is interested in collaborating with the candidate and thus in the implementation of the appointment procedure. The Senate of the home member institution shall consider the interest disclosed in the declaration.

In the process of assessing the fulfilment of conditions for appointment to a title, the regulations applicable as at the date of submitting the application are used. In the process of assessing the fulfilment of conditions for appointment to a title, the candidate’s relevant works are taken into consideration which

have been written or created and published or accepted for publication by the date of the filing of the application. These shall be defined in detail in the University's criteria.

A candidate can be appointed to a title in one or more habilitation fields.

Each application shall be treated independently and separately.”

2. Article 2

These amendments shall enter into force on the day after their publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia and shall be applied for all procedures initiated after the enforcement of these amendments.
