

In accordance with the constitutionally guaranteed autonomy of the University and pursuant to the Higher Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 32/12 - official consolidated version, with amendments, supplementations and corrections) and the Order on the reorganisation of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 28/00, with amendments, supplementations and corrections), the Senate of the University of Ljubljana, at its session of 29 May 2018, and the Management Board of the University of Ljubljana, at its session of 31 May 2018, adopted the following

### **amendments to the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana**

#### Article 1

In the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 4/2017, with amendments, supplementations and corrections), the 10<sup>th</sup> indent of Article 74 shall be amended to read as follows:

“- decides on the revocation of all academic and scientific titles, except on the revocation of the title of doctor of sciences”.

#### Article 2

In the Statutes of the University of Ljubljana (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 4/2017, with amendments, supplementations and corrections), Article 94 shall be amended to read as follows:

“In accordance with the law, a student may obtain special status or special needs status. The student shall obtain such status by a decision of the competent body of a Member based on an application in accordance with the University rules adopted by the Senate of the University.

The Member shall apply the rules to define the manner in which students with the status referred to in the previous paragraph are to complete their study requirements.”

#### Article 3

These amendments shall enter into force on the day after their publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia.
