Mladi raziskovalec ali mlada raziskovalka (MR) bo deloval/a na Oddelku za zgodovino FF UL. Usposabljal/a se bo na raziskovalnem področju sodobne zgodovine. V ospredju bo obča zgodovina v navezavi na slovenski in širši jugoslovanski prostor. V takšnem okviru bo tema doktorske disertacije temeljila na primarnih in sekundarnih virih domače in tuje provenience. Pri tem bodo imele prednost teme posvečene drugi polovici 20. stoletja, ki se bodo osredotočale na preučevanje slovenskega in jugoslovanskega delovanja v Gibanju neuvrščenih ali pa na odnose Slovenije/Jugoslavije z Evropskimi skupnostmi, Organizacijo združenih narodov ali katerokoli drugo mednarodno organizacijo.

Od bodoče/ga MR se pričakuje dobro poznavanje nacionalnih, transnacionalnih, političnih, gospodarskih, socialnih in kulturnih vidikov sodobne zgodovine, s posebnim poudarkom na diplomatski zgodovini. Na osnovi zgodovinskih virov mora znati zastavljati takšna raziskovalna vprašanja, ki bodo nudila inovativne pristope in odgovore v slovenskem in širšem regionalnem zgodovinopisju. Bodoči/a MR mora izkazovati samoiniciativnost in hkrati smisel za skupinsko delo ter dobre organizacijske sposobnosti. Pričakuje se obvladovanje verbalnega in pisnega (znanstvenega) komuniciranja v slovenskem in angleškem jeziku, ter zelo dobro razumevanje srbskega oz. hrvaškega jezika. Samostojno delo z osnovnimi programskimi orodji, pa tudi novimi tehnologijami v humanistiki, ji/mu ne sme predstavljati večjih težav in mora izkazovati željo po pridobivanju novih znanj tudi na tem področju.

Bodoči MR bo v času svojega usposabljanja sodeloval/a v nacionalnem raziskovalnem programu Slovenska zgodovina in na projektih, ki se izvajajo na katedri za sodobno zgodovino. Pričakuje se tudi aktivno sodelovanje pri prijavljanju novih projektov na domačih in tujih razpisih ter pri organiziranju dogodkov na oddelku. Vključen/a bo tudi v pedagoški proces članov katedre za sodobno zgodovino, zlasti mentorice, kamor spadajo seznanitve z vsebinami seminarjev, morebitna pomoč pri izvedbi vaj in konzultacij.

The Junior Researcher (JR) will work at the Department of History, Faculty of Arts. They will receive training in contemporary history, focusing on general history intertwined with Slovene and wider Yugoslav history. In this context, the topic of the thesis will be based on primary and

secondary sources of domestic and foreign provenance. Priority will be given to topics dedicated to the second half of the 20th Century, focusing on the research of Slovene and Yugoslav involvement with the Non-Aligned Movement or on relations between Slovenia/Yugoslavia and European Communities, the United Nations Organization or any other international organization.

The future JR is expected to have a good knowledge of national, transnational, political, economic, social and cultural aspects of contemporary history, with particular reference to diplomatic history. On the basis of historical sources, the JR must be able to form such research questions, which will offer innovative approaches and answers in Slovenian and broader regional historiography. The prospective JR must demonstrate initiative and a sense of teamwork, as well as good organizational skills. In addition to verbal and written (academic level) proficiency in Slovene and English, a very good understanding of Serbian or Croat is expected. Work with basic software tools should not present major difficulties, while the prospective JR should show desire to also acquire new knowledge in the field of new technologies in humanities.

In the course of their training, the future JR will participate in the national research program Slovene History and in projects carried out by the chair for contemporary history. Active participation is expected during application processes for new domestic and foreign projects, as well as in organizing department's events. The JR will also participate as a teaching assistant for the members of the chair for contemporary history, particularly in the classes carried out by their supervisor. This includes explaining the contents of the seminars and possible assistance in carrying out seminars as well as consultations.
