

## Utrecht Network Research Grant - Application Guidelines for Students

The Utrecht Network Research Grant is for self-organised mobility at one of the Utrecht Network partner universities. The grant is limited to thesis research on MA and PhD level. Students are allowed to take courses as well, but priority will be given to “only-research” students.

*Prerequisites:*

- MA/PhD level
- length of stay: 1 - 6 months (mobility is not restricted to semesters, but is also possible during the holidays).
- Students, who are eligible for an ERASMUS grant cannot apply for this grant.

*Grant:*

1000 euro max.

*Application documents:*

- Application form
- Letter of Motivation
- Letter of Recommendation by supervisor/programme coordinator
- Letter of Acceptance (by an academic supervisor/coordinator at the host institution)

*Application deadline:*

October 31<sup>st</sup>

All application documents must be handed in at the UN contact person of the home university.
