Mladi raziskovalec/mlada raziskovalka (MR) se bo usposabljal/-a v okviru potekajočih raziskav programske skupine Uporabna razvojna psihologija, in sicer na področjih (a) značilnosti in dejavnikov (varovalnih in dejavnikov tveganja) zgodnjega govornega razvoja in razvoja zgodnje pismenosti, (b) razvoja igre, (c) digitalnih medijev v povezavi z otrokovim razvojem in učenjem ter (č) starševstva. Usposabljal/-a se bo tudi za prenos znanstvenih ugotovitev v psihološko prakso.

Nadalje se bo MR usposabljal/-a v okviru razširjanja potekajočih in v prihodnje pridobljenih raziskav.

V usposabljanje se vključuje poglobljeni študij literature s področij (a) psiholoških raziskav, v okviru katerih se MR usposablja, (b) teme doktorske disertacije in (c) doktorskega študijskega programa Razvojnopsihološke študije. V ta program sodi opravljanje vseh obveznosti študijskega programa, priprava in potrditev teme disertacije ter izvedba vseh raziskovalnih dejavnosti, ki vodijo do uspešnega zagovora doktorske naloge.

V okviru dovoljenega števila ur bo MR sodeloval/-a v pedagoškem procesu, in sicer pri izvajanju vaj pri predmetih iz razvojne psihologije.

Poleg tega se bo vključeval/-a v mednarodno raziskovalno sodelovanje z Univerzo v Washingtonu, s katero trenutno poteka sodelovanje v raziskavi o pomenu družinske pismenosti in govora staršev za govorni razvoj malčkov.

Sodeloval/-a bo tudi pri pripravi in predstavitvi prispevkov na mednarodnih znanstvenih konferencah ter pri pripravi člankov za objavo v znanstvenih revijah.

Dodatni pogoji, ki jih morajo izpolnjevati kandidati/kandidatke za MR.

- Znanje o kompleksnih statističnih metodah in njihova uporaba (npr. strukturno modeliranje, analiza poti, konfirmatorna faktorska analiza).

The young researcher's (YR) work will be performed within the framework of the ongoing studies in the research program Applied Developmental Psychology, namely in the areas of (a) characteristics and factors (protective and risk factors) of early language and literacy development (b) development of play, (c) digital media in relation to child's development and learning, and (d) parenting. The YR will also be trained to apply the research findings into psychological practice.

Furthermore, the YR will be trained within the field that extends the current studies as well as in the studies, which will be acquired in the future.

The YR's training program includes in-depth studying of the scientific literature related to the topics of (a) psychological studies of the YR's field of training, (b) the YR's doctoral thesis, and (c) the doctoral study program Developmental Studies. The program also consists of fulfilment of all study obligations, preparation and confirmation of the doctoral thesis, and implementation of all research activities leading towards a successful defense of the doctoral dissertation.

The YR will also be involved in the educational process within the permitted limits, namely carrying out the exercises within the developmental psychology courses.

He/she will be included in an ongoing international study on the role of family literacy and parental speech in toddlers' language development, which is carried out in cooperation with the University of Washington.

He/she will engage in preparation/presentation of research contributions at international scientific conferences, and preparation/submission of research papers for publication in research journals.

The additional requirements for the YR candidate, which should also be met:

- The Master's degree in psychology.
- Fluency in the Slovenian and English language (speaking and writing, including technical psychological terminology in Slovenian and English).
- Research or professional paper in the field of psychology, at least accepted for a peer review (co-authorship).
- Knowledge on complex statistical methods and their application (e.g., structural equation modeling, path analyses, confirmatory factor analysis).
