Osrednje vsebinsko področje usposabljanja mlade raziskovalke/mladega raziskovalca je preučevanje učinkov kriz (kot je npr. mednarodna finančna in ekonomska kriza; pandemija COVIT-19) in skokovitega tehnološkega razvoja na javne politike, še posebej na javnopolitične inovacije in na pojave katastrof (zelo hitrih radikalnih sprememb javnih politik) (Dunn, 2018).

Teoretsko uokvirjanje se bo navezovalo na aktualne razprave o razmerjih med določenimi oblikami kapitalizma in spreminjajočih oblik vladanja (Wilke and Wilke, 2012), o hibridizaciji vladavin in s tem povezanimi problemi legitimnosti in etičnimi dilemami (Büthe, and Mattli, 2011; May, 2015; Tusikov, 2017; Verbruggen, and Havinga, 2017; Winfield and Jirotko, 2018).

Usposabljanje bo zajemalo tako vključevanje v temeljno raziskovanje programske skupine in v mednarodno sodelovanje programske skupine kot tudi razvoj politološkega in še posebej metodološkega znanja.

Pogoj je predhodna družboslovna izobrazba in aktivno znanje angleškega jezika. Zaželeni so: politološka izobrazba, poznavanje katerega od javnopolitičnih področij, poglobljeno družboslovno metodološko znanje in znanstvene objave.

The main research focus of Young Researcher's training is conducting research on impacts of crisis (such as international financial and economic crisis and the COVIT-19 pandemia) and swift technological developments on public policies, particularly on policy innovations and catastrophies (very fast and at the same time also radical changes in public policies) (Dunn, 2018).

Theoretical framing shall engage into current debates on relationships between particular modes of capitalism and the change in the predominant mode of governing (Wilke and Wilke, 2012), on hybridisation of governance and the related issues of legitimacy and ethical issues (Büthe, and Mattli, 2011; May, 2015; Tusikov, 2017; Verbruggen, and Havinga, 2017; Winfield and Jirotko, 2018).

The training will include active participation in the Political science research group basic research, in the the Political science research group international collaboration as well as the development of political science knowledge and (especially) methodological skills.

Conditions are previously completed social science education and active knowledge of English language. Beside that the following is desired: previously completed political science education, already existing knowledge on particular policy fields, thorough methodological knowledge and scientific publications.
