



## Joint Master's Degree History of South-Eastern Europe

The two-year **Joint Degree Program History of South-Eastern Europe** is aimed at highly motivated students with a background in humanities and a strong record of academic success. It offers specialized academic training in History of South-Eastern Europe and focuses on three consecutive core modules offering students insight into the history and historical anthropology of South-Eastern Europe in a wider context of European integration. The universities in the consortium (Cluj-Napoca / Romania, Graz / Austria, Ljubljana / Slovenia) are working together to guarantee a high quality international curriculum with regional aspects.

Students interested in the program apply to the coordinator at their chosen home university and will be able to draw on the expertise and focus of all the partners in the context of the joint degree program, as well as a summer school that will be offered on an annual basis to allow students to further specialize and gather additional ECTS. The mobility semester can be spent at one of the partner institutions in the consortium.

At the successful completion of the program students will be awarded a jointly conferred master degree automatically recognized in the countries of all consortium partners.

- **Degree:** Joint Master's Degree "History of South-Eastern Europe" (Master of Arts)
- **Partners:** Babeş-Bolyai University of Cluj-Napoca / Romania, University of Graz / Austria, University of Ljubljana / Slovenia
- **Credits:** 120 ECTS credits
- **Duration:** 2 years (4 semesters)
- **Mobility:** at least 1 semester = 30 ECTS Credits at partner university
- **Language of instruction:** German, Romanian or Slovenian (dep. on chosen home university)
- **Start of the program:** academic year 2007/08
- **Costs:** enrolment fees according to the respective universities' regulations.
- **Financial support:** The participating universities may offer a certain number of grants for mobility.

**Deadline for application is 1<sup>st</sup> September 2007 (receiving date)**
