

GRADING SYSTEM FOR SELECTION at the Call for Enrolment

If the number of candidates meeting the enrolment criteria exceeds the number of places available, the candidates will be selected in line with the criteria determined on the 3rd session of the Programme Council Biomedicine (17 February 2022).
